We recognise:

- The importance of ensuring the wellbeing of all children and staff at our school.
- That the wellbeing of school leaders is important and that leaders should act as role models with regard to their own wellbeing before they can ensure that of anyone else.
- That wellbeing extends far beyond the occasional staff breakfast or box of chocolates and includes
 - Ensuring an appropriate work life balance,
 - o Minimising workload wherever possible,
 - Ensuring autonomy, and
 - Valuing people's voices and views.
- That ensuring the wellbeing of our children, is vital to supporting their learning.

We commit:

- To ensuring mechanisms are in place to ensure that all voices are heard and that the views of all are valued.
- To considering the impact on work life balance and the affect on workload of each new policy and initiative that is introduced.
- To providing adequate funding to support the identified need of both children and staff wherever possible to do so.
- To providing links within the curriculum to wellbeing topics and activities to enable children to develop their own strategies for maintaining wellbeing throughout their lives.
- To monitoring this statement in practice to ensure that it is real and meaningful and not just words on a page.
- To putting wellbeing at the heart of everything we do.
